### **[Eligibility]**

**Those who have received or are currently receiving mental health treatment.**

### **[Application Type]**

**Paintings are the subject, and the theme is free.**

### **[Exhibition location]**

**We plan to have two exhibition methods: an online exhibition on the website and a physical exhibition on the pedestrian deck and PRCP&WACP 2025. You can choose either one or both of them.**

### **[How to Apply]**

- **Application deadline: Must arrive by 25(Fri) July 2025**
- **Please send a scanned or photographed version of your entry (PDF or JPEG, Data up to 30MB) via the application form.**

\*If you wish to have a realistic exhibition, the following high-resolution data is required. For JPEG data: 90cm x 90cm, 240dpi or higher For PDF data: 90cm x 90cm, 300dpi or higher

• We ask for artwork from people with mental health issues to help us deepen our understanding of art by researching the significance of art for mental health issues and presenting this information at academic conferences and in academic journals.

• We will do our best to display as many of your entries as possible, but space is limited for realistic exhibits on the pedestrian deck and PRCP&WACP 2025, so we may close the exhibition once a certain number is reached.

• If you wish to cancel your online exhibit, please let us know and we will withdraw it. (Please note that this may take up to two weeks.)

• The copyright of the artwork belongs to the applicant. However, the organizer is free to use the works for photography, publication on the organizer's website, display at the site of the Annual Meeting, and display on the pedestrian deck from Hamamatsucho to the pier.

• Personal information will be handled strictly. If you wish to use a pseudonym when exhibiting, posting or displaying your work, please indicate so.

• Please agree in advance that the images will not offend public order and morals, and will not infringe on the copyrights or portrait rights of third parties.

• No gratuities will be charged.
